Requested Action:

All NYSEG TGP Pool Operators **downstream of Station 245** must keep actual daily takes out of the system equal to or less than scheduled quantities regardless of their cumulative imbalance position.

Reason for Requested Action:

As described in TGP Notice ID 361991 posted 1/4/2017 2:36: PM, due to colder weather moving into the northeast TGP has issued an OFO for **downstream of STA 245 on the 200 Line**.

NYSEG, in support of TGP's notice, is requesting that ESCOs take the appropriate action to respond to TGP's OFO, **downstream of station 245**. NYSEG is requiring TGP Pool Operators downstream 245 to keep actual daily takes out of the system equal to or less than scheduled quantities regardless of their cumulative imbalance position.

Additionally, NYSEG is requiring all TGP Pool Operators to adhere to all pipeline requirements including any limitations imposed by the pipeline on nomination imbalance tolerances.

Potential Actions:

Any costs NYSEG incurs from pipeline imbalances will be passed on to the offending shippers

Additional Information:

This OFO is specifically for downstream STA 245 on the 200 Line only and will remain in effect until further notice. The System Alert for the rest of the TGP system effective 1/6/2017 is still in effect until further notice.
